Rate (TCR)

- What is a kWh?
 - A kWh stands for kilowatt-hour the unit used to measure energy use. 1 kWh will power a 40 watt light bulb for 25 hours.
- What is the Tariff Comparison Rate (TCR)? TCR is a rate per kWh that allows you to compare your tariff to other tariffs by taking account of the unit rate and standing

Explaining your Gas Statement

Definitions

Volume Conversion Factor: this is when we convert your meter units to metric. If you have an imperial meter this will be 2.83, and it you have a metric meter this will be 1.

Volume Correction: gas regulations require us to take into account the changes in your volume of gas based upon temperature and pressure. This is reflected by using the industry standard correction factor of 1.02264.

Calorific Value: the measurement of the energy content of gas which varies throughout the year.

Convert to kWh: this is the final stage of the process where we divide the answer by 3.6 to give the number of kilowatt-hours.

Formula

We converted your Gas units to kWh using the following formula:

Meter Units 190 Volume Conversion Factor 2.83 Metric Units x 1.02264 Volume Correction Calorific Value x 39.3 Convert to kWh / 3.6
